This highly practical two-day hands-on cadaveric course will focus on internal fixation, for example locking and non-locking plates, intramedullary pins, K-wires and orthopaedic wire. The course will review the principles and practice of each of these techniques. The days will comprise of multiple surgical exercises and you will be able to choose fracture types and surgical techniques that you wish to perfect.
